
How to play

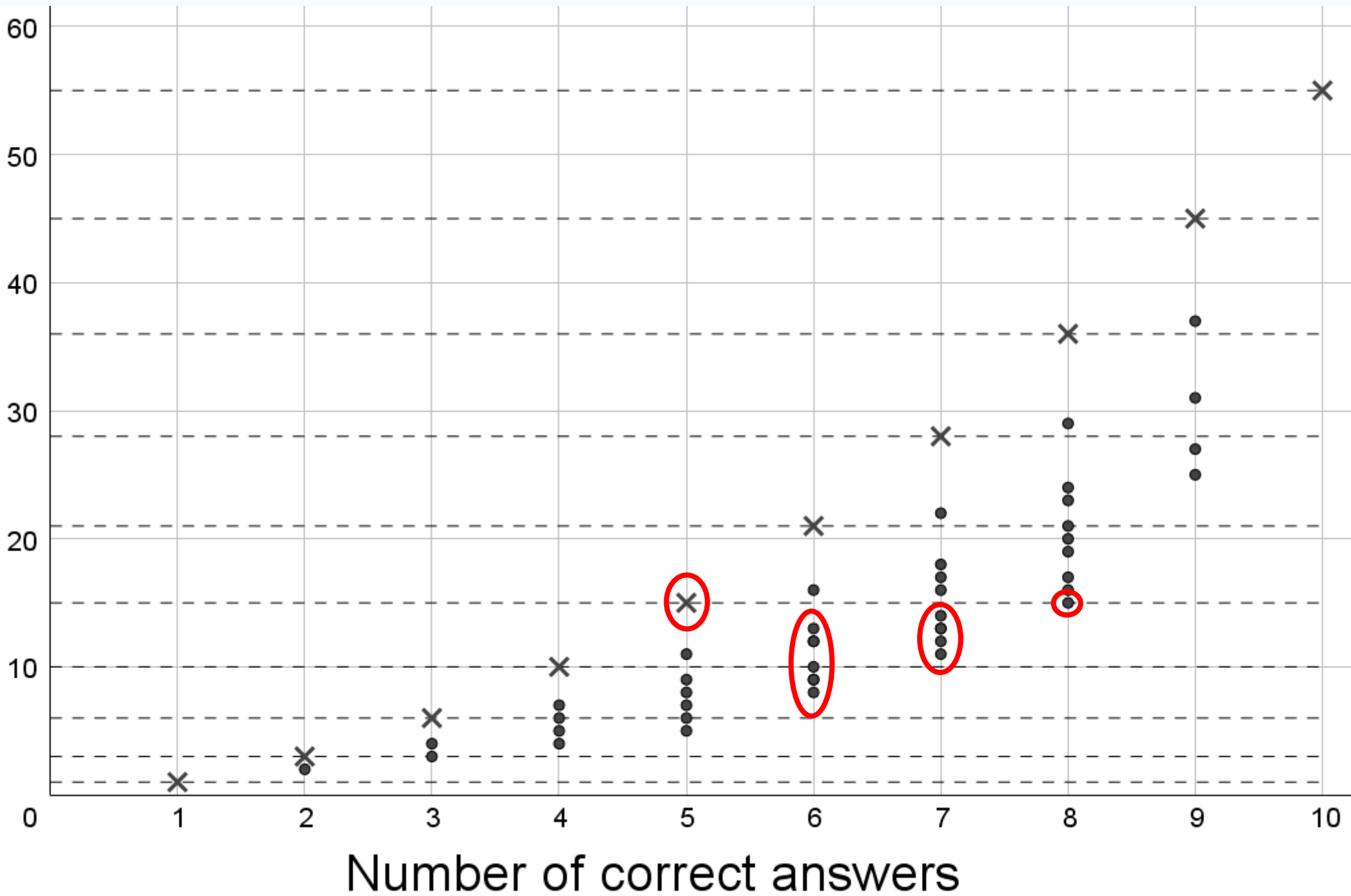
